**BRIDGE RV PARK & CAMPGROUND** Just an hour drive from Portland, OR on the North Shore of the Columbia River in the heart of "The Gorge". Bridge RV Park has **35 Full Hook-up sites from 35'-80' and 15 tent sites**. High speed Internet, coin-operated laundry, **showers**, propane.

**EAGLE CREEK CAMPGROUND** USFS campground located near Bonneville Dam, 2 miles west of Cascade Locks. **20 sites, NO RV Hookups, accommodates trailers up to 22'. Fee is \$15 per day**. Cold water available, toilet and picnic table at the trailhead. Open approximately May – Sept. **Phone: (541) 308-1700**

**HERMAN CREEK HORSE CAMP** Elevation 100' **Offers 8 Sites**. Vault toilets, loading dock, hitching rails and can accommodate **trailers up to 22'**. Overnight camping fee is \$10 per night. No reservations are required, first come, first served. The site also serves as a trailhead for Herman Creek Trail #406 and the Pacific Crest Trail #2000. **Phone (541) 308-1700**

**KEYLOCK CAMPGROUND** 6890 Hess Rd, Mt. Hood Elevation 1600' We have **20 Camp Sites** with water, porta-potties and picnic tables. We also offer areas for **Tents, RV's and social events**. **Fee is \$15 per day**. **Phone (541) 352-7897**

**KINGSLEY RESERVOIR** Elevation 3200' **20 sites**. Hood River County campground located west of Hood River on the edge of the Cascades. Developed sites with pit toilets and boat ramp with parking. **No showers**. Good trails for mountain biking. **Laurence Lake Kinnikinnick** Elevation 3000' **20 sites**. Mt Hood Forest Service campground, located approximately 10 miles South of Parkdale via Clear Creek Road to Laurence Lake Road. On a reservoir with fishing and boating. **Fee is \$12 per night**. No drinking water, electricity or handicap facilities. **14 day limit**. No Reservations. **Phone (541) 352-6002**

**LOST LAKE RESORT** Elevation 3200' **124 Tent & RV Sites** Located on the North Side of Mt. Hood. USFS public campground. No reservations. Fireplaces, water, restroom, general store, showers, group camping, handicap facilities. Fishing, boat & canoe rentals (**motors strictly prohibited**) mountain biking, hiking, access to Pacific Crest Trail. **Phone (541) 386-6366**

**MARINE PARK CASCADE LOCKS** Elevation 60' **15 sites** Marine Park is operated by the Port of Cascade Locks, home of the Sternwheeler Columbia Gorge riverboat. Cascade Locks Historical Museum, Visitors Center and gift shop, 37-slip marina and Thunder Island.

**MEMALOOSE STATE PARK** Elevation 100' **110 sites** Located on the Columbia River. **45 sites with full hook-ups, RV's to 60' and 60 tent spaces**. **Showers**, RV dump station. Historical interest point and views. Reservations accepted. Discovery season rates. **Tent sites are \$19, full hook up is \$24**.

**NOTTINGHAM CAMPGROUND** Elevation 3300' **23 sites** USFS Campground in the Mt. Hood National Forest. Right along HWY 35. No reservations. All sites have fire pits. **Trailer sites up to 32', no hookups, no boating, no drinking water. River fishing. Fees \$12 per night.**

**ROUSTON PARK** Elevation 2500' **20 sites** Hood River County park located 7 miles south of the community of Mt. Hood on HWY 35. Stream fishing on the Hood River. Drinking water, flush toilets. Not recommended for trailers. **All sites are \$12 per night.** No picnic sites or handicap facilities. Open April 1 – October 31. **Phone (541) 386-2616**

**SUNSET MOTEL & RV PARK** **17 RV sites with full hook-ups.** Located at the West end of Hood River with off-street parking, gorge views and shopping nearby.
